



Martellozzo Family, Camposampiero, 1960 The Piera Martellozzo winery was founded in 1899 in

Camposampiero near the town of Padova, by Piera's Grandfather, Giovanni, but it was Piera's Father, Mario, that really expanded the company and developed the company awareness both in Italy and in foreign markets.

Terroir

FRIULI GRAVE DOC AREA



Friuli Grave is a DOC covering a large area of land in Friuli-Venezia Giulia, between the **Alps** and the **Adriatic sea**. The region's combination of soil, climate and situation make for excellent wines, and viticulture here dates back to Roman times.

The area is made up of some 16,000 acres (6500ha) of vineyards.

FRIULI GRAVE DOC AREA



Friuli Grave takes its name from the gravelly, alluvial soil that characterizes the zone. The stony, limestone-rich soil originated in the mountains and has been deposited across the plains over the years. The extensive stretch of stones beneath the vines reflects heat and light during the day to help the grapes ripen, as well as acting like a radiator during the night to maintain a constant and even mesoclimate. Drainage is also excellent, mitigating the effects of any heavy rainfall.

FRIULI GRAVE DOC AREA



The Adriatic sea and the Alps both have an influence on the climate here. The nearby mountains protect the valley from icy winds blowing from the north and the close Adriatic Sea tempers the heat of the plains.


